RESEARCH

PhD Dissertation: 'The Re-creation and Transformation of the Archaic Art of Cyprus to Contemporary Art'

The research involved an enquiry through a creative process grounded on the study of the heritage of Cyprus and specifically the archaic art. Cyprus during the Archaic Period 8th-5th century BCE developed its own artistic idiom, which was unique to the island. The research linked the two disciplines, archaeology and art, in order to understand and recreate the ancient past and involved the direct collaboration with specialized archaeologists. The research themes were explored in the form of theory and practice, and are the following:

- History & tradition within contemporary art
- The role of the artist today in studying the ancient past
- The common fundamentals between ancient art and children's art
- Contemporary society and heritage: Investigation of ways on how archaic art can find possible uses within the contemporary visual identity and culture of Cyprus.
